

REGULATIONS ON FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

57.§ According to the Doctoral Study and Examination regulations (VI. Addendum and regulations, Regulations on foreign language proficiency, 57.§)

- Candidates who possess at least one state-recognized medium “level B2” complex language certificate (formerly: grade C) or an equivalent documentary proof, may apply for the doctoral training.
- The condition for applying for a Comprehensive Exam is the knowledge of an additional foreign language that must be attested by at least a state-recognized basic level C language certification or an equal language certificate, its recognition is decided by the Head of the Doctoral School.
- Of the above mentioned language certificates can be accepted of the following languages: English, German, French, Italian, Russian, Latin, Spanish. Candidates must apply to the head of the Doctoral School for the acceptance of certificates of languages different from the languages listed above by referring to the fact, that the research topic of their dissertation is connected to the given language. In case of Non-Hungarian speaking doctoral students the Hungarian language can be recognized as a second foreign language by the decision of the head of the Doctoral School.
- Non-Hungarian speaking doctoral students must attest the competence of at least two foreign languages based on the 14§ of the Government Decree No. 137/2008 (V. 16.) “On the certified examination of foreign language attainment and on the nostrification in the Republic of Hungary of language certificates of foreign language attainment issued abroad”.
